RESPONSIBILITIES: Coordinate operations and activities within an assigned Division; participate in the development and implementation of goals, objectives, policies and priorities for the Fire Medical Department; identify resource needs; recommend and implement policies and procedures; meet with managerial staff regularly to discuss future plans and progress toward goals and objectives of the Fire Medical Department. Participate in training, motivating and evaluating personnel; provide or coordinate staff training; develop curriculum and continuing education program; work with employees to correct deficiencies; implement discipline and recommend terminations as appropriate. Direct, coordinate and review the work plan for the assigned personnel; meet with staff to identify and resolve problems; assign work activities and projects; monitor work flow; review and evaluate work products, methods and procedures; review monthly report on progress and activities of staff. Review and evaluate procedures used by personnel to assure use of acceptable methods; schedule and participate in clinical review conferences; may provide classroom and on-the-job training; may develop teaching curriculum and continuing education programs. Participate in the development and administration of the Fire Medical Department budget in assigned area; forecast funds needed for staffing, equipment, materials and supplies; monitor and approve expenditures for assigned area of responsibility.

QUALIFICATIONS: Associates Degree or higher from a regionally accredited agency, BA/BS preferred. 12 months as a Captain (or its equivalency) with a career fire service with EMS response. Knowledge of emergency medical care theory, procedures, equipment, application, maintenance, and training methods used in emergency medical care. Knowledge of operational characteristics, services and activities of comprehensive fire suppression and prevention programs and ambulance service programs. Preference given for experience as accredited and fire based EMS agency. Possession of a valid Motor Vehicle Operators License; Possession of an Advanced EMT or Paramedic Certification in the State of Kansas or National Registry, Fire Officer I IFSAC certification, IS100, IS200, G300, IS700, IS800 NIMS Training. Successful candidate will Obtain Fire Inspector I and Fire Officer II IFSAC certification, Blue Card Incident Command certification and Fire Officer (FO) designation through the Center for Public Safety Excellence (CPSE) within 18 months of accepting position. The successful candidate must pass a background check, psychological exam and post-offer City physical, including a drug screen.
